SBA Economic Injury Loan Deadline is December 6 *Business owners still have time to apply*

FORT WORTH, TX -- Businesses in some Texas counties have until **December 6, 2004** to file applications for low-interest disaster loans from the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA). The SBA's Economic Injury Disaster Loans are available for businesses dependent on farmers and ranchers sustaining crop losses due to excessive rain, high winds, and a tornado that occurred from October 5 – 9, 2003. Farmers and ranchers are not eligible for these SBA loans. However, nurseries that are victims of drought disasters can apply. Businesses in the following counties are eligible to apply:

Burlleson

Falls
Leon

Limestone
Madison

Milam
Robertson

These loans are intended to assist businesses in offsetting working capital losses which they suffered as a result of the severe weather reducing the crop income of the area farmers and ranchers. Small businesses claiming to have been physically injured by the disaster are not eligible.
