SBA TO CLOSE CLEVELAND DISASTER FIELD OFFICE ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 18

CLEVELAND, OH – The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) will close its disaster field office in Cuyahoga County on Wednesday, Aug. 18, according to SBA Disaster Area Director Michael C. Allen.

Allen announced today that the office located in the Prospect Park Building, 4614 Prospect Avenue in Cleveland will be open Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. before ceasing operation at the close of business on Wednesday, Aug. 18.

“We kept this office open after the deadline to assist the local residents that may have had additional questions about the disaster loan program or needed extra help in the assistance process,” Allen said.

The deadline to apply for assistance was Aug. 2. Victims with additional questions about the assistance processes are urged to come in and personally meet with an SBA loan officer before the office closes.

As a result of this disaster, SBA has approved more than 498 low-interest disaster loans for over six million dollars to homeowners, renters and businesses in Ohio.
