Comments:**Graded Agency:**

Under Public Law 109-461, the priority of sources for VA procurements puts service-disabled Veteran-owned small business (SDVOSB) first and Veteran-owned small business (VOSB) second and ahead of all other small business categories. While this gives VA an advantage in meeting the SDVOSB statutory goal, it makes achievement of the woman-owned small business goal and the Historically Underutilized Business Zone goal extremely challenging for VA.

SBA:

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) met 3 of its 5 prime contracting goals: Small Business, Small Disadvantaged Business and Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business. However, it did not meet its prime contracting goals for Women Owned Small Business and HUBZone.

Fiscal year 2010 prime contracting achievement saw increases over FY2009 in all categories: Small Business, Women Owned Small Business, Small Disadvantaged Business, Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business and HUBZone.

VA regularly attends Small Business Procurement Advisory Council meetings.
