## **Comments:**

### Graded Agency:

NSF attributes the reduction in its overall scorecard grade to the inclusion of overseas contracts in the small business eligible dollars. NSF's two largest contracts, Arctic and Antarctic Support, are performed overseas by a large business. These contracts accounted for over 50% of NSF's annual obligations in FY 2018. Due to the size, complexity and the place of performance, there are no small businesses that can perform this work. Without the inclusion of overseas contracts in the small business eligible dollars, NSF would have accomplished all of its socio-economic FY 2018 prime goals. NSF was able to achieve its Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB), prime contracting goals and improve its HUBZone achievement in FY 2018. NSF will continue to actively reach out to the small business community by increasing our outreach and networking activities.
