Comments:

Graded Agency: In FY 2019, NASA maintained its SBA Scorecard grade of "A" due to more than \$3.1 billion in obligations directly to small businesses, as well as another \$2.9 billion that was subcontracted to small businesses from NASA's large prime suppliers. The latter resulted in NASA reaching or exceeded all of its subcontracting goals in fiscal year 2019. These multi-billion dollar procurements continue to demonstrate NASA's commitment to small businesses.
