SUBJECT: PMQD Screens (14-15, 21-25, & 28)

EFFECTIVE: 11/1/2011

This is to inform you that PMQD screens 14-15, 21-25, & 28 will be retired effective 10/15/2011 as part of the Loan Management and Accounting System (LMAS) Incremental Improvement Projects (IIP). The retired screens are search screens and not input screens. You will be able to conduct the same search as the retired PMQD functionality on the GLS WEB applications Electronic Loan Information System (ELIPS), Centralized Loan Chron System (CLCS), Loan Associated Name and Addresses (LANA) and Electronic Lending System (ELENL/ETRAN) systems.

What will be affected? The table below identifies the screens that will be turned off and the systems that will have the new functionality. The retired screens **will not be available** after 8:00 AM Saturday, 11/5/2011:

Who will be affected? All employees that work with loan management and accounting related transactions for Office of Capital Access (OCA), Office of Disaster Assistance (ODA), Office of Chief Financial Officer (OCFO), Office of General Counsel (OGC), Office of Surety Guarantees, and Office of Field Operations (OFO) will be affected.

Why is this taking place? The retired screens are being migrated to the web environment to support the Agency migrating off of the mainframe environment.
