iPad At-A-Glance (front)

Front facing camera, Multi-Touch screen, App icons, Status bar, and Home button



iPad At-A-Glance (back)

Back camera, Sleep/Wake button, Microphone, Headphone jack, Side switch, Volume controls


iPad Lock Screen

To unlock your device, place your finger over the right-facing arrow and slide your finger to the right; then type your passcode



SBA iPad Home Screen

Your Home screen has been organized to provide you with specific Apps you will need for the pilot, such as *Good for Enterprise* and *Citrix Receiver*



Charging your iPad


Charge your device by connecting the iPad to a power outlet using the provided *Dock Connector* to a *USB Cable* and 10W USB power adapter



Scrolling


Drag your finger up or down to scroll. You can also scroll sideways in apps, such as *Good*, *Safari*, *Photos*, and *Maps*


Notes

Your own personal notepad app




Auto-correction and Spell Checking

iPad automatically corrects misspellings or makes suggestions as you type. When iPad suggests a word, you can accept the suggestion without interrupting your typing.



Screen Brightness

To adjust the screen's brightness, double-click the Home button to view the multitasking bar. Flick from left to right, then drag the brightness slider



Maps

Tap **Search**, then tap the search field to bring up the keyboard. Type an address or other information, then tap **Search**

Photos

Tap a thumbnail to see the photo or video full-screen. You can also pinch to open or close an album, view a photo or video full-screen, or return to thumbnail view



Videos

Tap **Videos**, then tap a category of videos. Tap the video you want to watch.



Portrait or Landscape

You can view iPad's apps in either portrait or landscape orientation. rotate the iPad and the screen rotates too, adjusting automatically to fit the new orientation

Zooming in or out

While viewing photos, web pages, mail, or maps, you can zoom in and out. Pinch two fingers together or apart. For photos and web pages, you can double-tap (tap twice quickly) to zoom in, then double tap again to zoom out

Good for Enterprise is a powerful, easy-to-use mobility suite that supports mobile collaboration with a great end-user experience on popular handhelds – like the iPhone, iPad, and Android devices – without compromising IT security and control.



What you can do with *Citrix Receiver*: access your SBA applications and Windows desktop at your office, home or on the road; keep your information stored on SBA's secure servers and not your iPad; seamlessly move from desktop to iPad.




