SUBJECT: Required TINs in CPC System

EFFECTIVE: 12/14/2007

What's Old?

The U.S. Department of Treasury requires Federal agencies to include a payee Tax Identification Number (TIN) on each payment submitted by the agency. This allows Treasury to identify and offset eligible payments to satisfy a delinquent debt owed to the Government.

What's Changing?

With this notice, the SBA's Care and Preservation of Collateral System (CPC) will expand input edits (that currently require TINs for some payments) to require TINs for all payment type codes in the CPC system.
