Thank you for your recent letter on behalf of Mrs. Rhonda Grey, regarding the status of an increase request to her approved business loan with the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) for losses caused by severe storms and tornadoes in April and May 2011.

On September 11, 2011, Mrs. Grey and her husband, Mr. Harold Grey, Jr., were approved for an \$810,400 business loan to totally rebuild their commercial real estate. In June 2012, the Greys requested an increase to cover additional costs to complete the reconstruction process. The Processing and Disbursement Center (PDC) in Fort Worth, Texas, advised Mrs. Grey of additional items required to process her increase request. On June 27, 2012, the Greys submitted the required.

On receipt of your letter, the increase request was under review. I am pleased to advise you that the Greys' loan has been increased to \$1,136,500.
