Thank you for your recent inquiry on behalf of Mr. Chakradhar Yerneni, of MegaDoot Technologies (MegaDoot), regarding the status of his firm's HUBZone application.

The time to process a HUBZone application is generally 90 days. Please keep in mind, however, that processing times for individual applications can vary greatly depending on the complexity of a case and an applicant's responsiveness to any requests for additional information. MegaDoot's application was received on January 26, 2012. Based on the information provided in the initial application, zero of MegaDoot's employees resided in a HUBZone. According to 13 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 126.200 (4) the applicant firm must have at least 35% of all employees residing in a HUBZone. Mrs. Michelle Scruggs, President of MegaDoot was notified of this decision on January 30, 2012, via e-mail to michelles@megadoot.com.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause Mr. Yerneni, and would like to invite him to reapply at any time if he believes MegaDoot meets all eligibility requirements. He is also welcome to check the status of his application by contacting the HUBZone Helpdesk at hubzone@sba.gov.
