Thank you for your recent inquiry on behalf of Ms. Alexandra Tyler regarding the salary overpayments to her while on workers' compensation.

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) is actively communicating with the U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Finance Center (NFC) representatives to help with resolving Ms. Tyler's request for assistance with her salary overpayment discrepancies.

In our April 10, 2012, response, SBA provided all available documentation within its system of records related to clearing up the discrepancy with Ms. Tyler's over-payment. That response advised that NFC is the lead agency responsible for providing the information now needed to directly assist Ms. Tyler with the bringing this matter to an amicable end. The SBA cannot generate corrected W-2s or provide first-hand knowledge concerning the status of returned checks and credits/updates made by NFC. You may be assured that SBA remains engaged and supportive in our efforts to assist Ms. Tyler, NFC, and your office with resolving her salary overpayment discrepancies.
