Thank you for your inquiry on behalf of Ms. Vicki Penney-Rohner regarding her request for assistance in repayment of her U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) Disaster Home Loan.

According to SBA loan records on December 6, 2006, SBA approved a \$14,000 disaster loan to Ms. Penney-Rohner. Subsequently, after numerous attempts to contact Ms. Penny-Rohner to offer repayment arrangements, the loan became delinquent on October 7, 2011. As mandated by the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996, on March 11, 2012, SBA referred the loan to the U.S. Department of Treasury (Treasury) for further collection efforts. Treasury has assumed collection responsibilities and SBA no longer services this loan.
