

Advocacy Comments on the Designation of Revised Critical Habitat For the Western Snowy Plover

On May 19, 2011 the Office of Advocacy (Advocacy) filed public comments with the Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) in response to the Designation of Revised Critical Habitat for the Western Snowy Plover. A copy of Advocacy's comments may be viewed at www.sba.gov/advocacy.

- On March 22, 2011, FWS published a proposed rule to designate critical habitat for the Western Snowy Plover. FWS is proposing to designate approximately 28,261 acres as critical habitat in Washington, Oregon, and California.
- Advocacy has submitted comments reflecting its concern that FWS has not complied with its obligations under the Regulatory Flexibility Act by publishing an Initial Regulatory Flexibility Analysis or certifying that the rule will not have a significant economic impact on a substantial number of small businesses.
