



SBIR Awards



This is SBIR.gov - the SBA's home the SBIR Program! The site contains answers to pretty much any question you might have about the Program.

To begin your walkthrough, let's assume that you're an applicant that would like to learn more about SBIR awards.

In the center, select "I'm an 'Applicant'". Here, you'll be able to scroll through useful information, including Eligibility Criteria, Company Registration, Submitting a Proposal, Next Steps, and Additional Resources.


SBIR/STTR Application



Now, let's say you want to learn more about the Application. In the top-right menu, select the 'Resource' tab.

The resulting 'FAQ' page contains a list of both general and specific information, including the size rule, performance benchmarks, and the company registry.

Finding Funding



So now that you know HOW to apply - you need to know WHAT you should be applying for!

Under the "Funding" tab , select "Open" from the dropdown menu.

Here you'll find a list of all open topics that are currently accepting applications. You can easily sort and filter by Agency, Phase and Program.

Under the News section, select "Success Stories".

You can also check out the latest "Award Listing" and "Company Listing" under the "Awards" tab as well!
