### SBA Closing Humphreys County Business Recovery Center Sept. 24

**ATLANTA** - [The U.S. Small Business Administration](#) (SBA) announced today that due to a steady decrease in activity, the Business Recovery Center (BRC) in Humphreys County, **Tennessee** will cease operations at 4:30 p.m. Friday, Sept. 24. SBA opened the Center to provide one-on-one assistance to businesses affected by the Severe Storms and Flooding on Aug. 21.

“I encourage anyone who has not completed their disaster loan application to visit the center before the closing to meet with a Customer Service Representative for one-on-one assistance,” said Kem Fleming, director of SBA’s Field Operations Center East.

SBA’s Customer Service Representatives are available through Friday, Sept. 24 at the BRC to answer program questions, assist in completing the SBA application, and help with the reconsideration process. The Center is located and open as indicated below:

Applicants have until the filing deadline to submit an application and may apply online using the Electronic Loan Application (ELA) via SBA’s secure website at [DisasterLoanAssistance.sba.gov/ela/s](https://DisasterLoanAssistance.sba.gov/ela/s) and should apply under SBA declaration #17039, not the COVID-19 incident.

To be considered for all forms of disaster assistance, applicants should register online at [DisasterAssistance.gov](https://DisasterAssistance.gov) or download the FEMA mobile app. If online or mobile access is unavailable, applicants should call the FEMA toll-free helpline at 800-621-3362. Those who use 711-Relay or Video Relay Services should call 800-621-3362.

Businesses and individuals may also obtain information and loan applications by calling the SBA’s Customer Service Center at 1-800-659-2955 (1-800-877-8339 for the deaf and hard-of-hearing) or emailing [DisasterCustomerService@sba.gov](mailto:DisasterCustomerService@sba.gov). Loan applications can also be downloaded at [sba.gov/disaster](https://sba.gov/disaster). Completed applications should be mailed to: U.S. Small Business Administration, Processing and Disbursement Center, 14925 Kingsport Road, Fort Worth, TX 76155.

The filing deadline to return applications for physical property damage is **Oct. 22, 2021**. The deadline to return economic injury applications is **May 23, 2022**.
